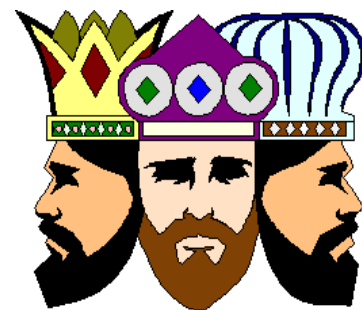

### **Bad Weather Cancellations**



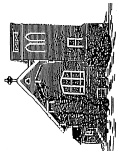
