It was home to three major textile mills. Old mills are a common site in these towns many refurbished for both residential and retail use. Plainfield is located in the heart of “The Last Green Valley”, a National Heritage Corridor. When there is a need to travel you are three hours from New York City, forty minutes from the ocean, and less than two hours from Boston.
